

GROW Ministries Family Membership Code of Conduct Agreement

Our Membership Code of Conduct is put in place to protect GROW Ministries Inc - Non Profit as well as the families in agreement.

Each event or GROW sponsored activity provides opportunities for training our children in appropriate behavior, as well as exercising Godly conduct as parents, role models, and women of God.

- Each parent is responsible to properly attend to their own children at all times, it is not the responsibility of GROW or other members to correct or parent your child.
- No child is permitted to exasperate other children present with bullying, teasing, rough play or crude talk.
- Behavior in the form of threats, physical contact or striking is not allowed including defacement or destruction of property.

Learning good public behavior means talking to our children before we arrive about what is expected and correcting them when necessary.

If your child exhibits any of the above behavior at a GROW sponsored event, your membership may be forfeited. GROW reserves the right to revoke membership if the code of conduct is violated.

Leadership will notify you of any offense that requires your attention the first time verbally, the second time in writing, and the third offense we will revoke your membership and your membership fees will be forfeited.

- Please be courteous of other families, if you believe that your child may have a contagious illness - please refrain from sharing those germs.

GROW Ministries is a non-profit ministry, we are women of God striving to cultivate a tribe of like minded families with expectations in line with biblical principals.

- As moms we are role models to our children and to each other, and we have a responsibility to act in accordance with the bible. We are not perfect, however we are responsible for practicing Christian behavior at all times.
